1.	Stop talking people and let's start talking to people. Ephesians 4:29 / Galatians 6:1
Ne	xt Step – Today, I commit to stop talking about people and start talking to people.
2.	Learn to with Matthew 18:15 NLT "If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back."
3.	Stop to Gossip. (I'm just concerned and listening to gossip, not spreading it!) Proverbs 17:4 A wicked person listens to deceitful lips; a liar pays attention to a destructive tongue. Why do you listen? 1 Samuel 24:9 It takes two to tango. Proverbs 20:19 / Love doesn't listen to evil. 1 Corinthians 13:6-7
