- 1. The apostles' teaching
- 2. To fellowship with one another (Also see Hebrews 10:23-25)
- 3. The breaking of bread
- 4. To prayer
- 5. They continued to meet together in the temple courts, and they broke bread in their homes together with glad and sincere hearts. *Large group setting and small groups*.

I believe this is still our pattern and model for church growth today. And as far as I can tell God is showing no signs of slowing down! He still wants to add to his church daily!
