Surrendered and

"There are thousands and tens of thousands of men and women in Christian work, brilliant men and women, rarely gifted men and women, men and women who are making great sacrifices, men and women who have put all conscious sin out of their lives, yet who, nevertheless, have stopped short of absolute surrender to God and therefore have stopped short of fullness of power." R.A. Torrey

Notice that Jesus was filled with the Holy Spirit and led by the Holy Spirit. Luke 4:1 / Luke 4:14 You must surrender to God to be filled with the Spirit.

- You can't be filled with the Spirit if you are filled with yourself!
- Surrendering to Christ Jesus and being filled with the Spirit is an ongoing process.

What do you do when you realize that you are on the throne of your life?

- Confess self-lordship as sin and ask Jesus to forgive you.
 - Surrender to His leadership in your life.
- Start over again and try to maintain a life that is fully surrendered to Him.
 - Ask God to not only forgive you but ask Him to use you again.

Next Step: I come to the altar today and surrender fully to God.

- Surrender your sins.
- Surrender your desires.
- Surrender what's good about you and surrender what's bad about you.
- Surrender your opinions and wants.
- Surrender yourself fully to His will and plan for your life.
