THE KEY TO THE BLESSED LIFE IS A HEART OF GENEROSITY.

Proverbs 11:24 One man gives freely, (not less) yet gains even more; another withholds unduly, (But instead of having more, which is the logical assumption.) but comes to poverty. What kind of person will prosper? Proverbs 11:25 A generous man will prosper; he who refreshes others will himself be refreshed.

Sowing and Reaping 2 Corinthians 9:6-7

What happens to you are a cheerful abundant giver? 2 Corinthians 9:8; 11 Blessed in Every Way!

THREE MINDSETS WHEN IT COMES TO GENEROUSITY

- 1) THE <u>BAG</u> MINDSET: NOT ENOUGH. People who live this way are the people who believe and say, "We would like to be generous, but we don't have enough." Haggi 1:6 NKJV The problem with this is that you are putting your faith in what is in the bag rather than a generous God.
 - Judas Had This Mindset: Mark 14:3-; 10
- 2) THE <u>BASKET</u> MINDSET: MORE THAN ENOUGH. People who believe that God is an abundant God, and we can trust Him. We have more than enough and we can give freely. Deuteronomy 28:4-6 Your basket will be blessed.
- Jesus gave an interesting teaching on the basket one time. He talked about two baskets used by two different sets of people in a grain field. Luke 6:38 / Proverbs 11:24-25 ... The amount you give will determine the amount you get back" (verses 38, NLT).
- A little boy with a Basket Mindset. He had a lunch basket. John 6:9 "Blessed Is Better!" Jesus blessed what was given, it multiplied and thousands were feed by what the boy gave. When everyone had eaten, there were twelve baskets full of leftovers. Proverb 11:24
- **3)** THE <u>BARN</u> MINDSET: INFINITELY MORE THAN ENOUGH. Deuteronomy 28:8 Imagine that you are faithful with what's in the bag and then you are faithful with what's in the baskets and then God gives you barns that are overflowing!
- The Faithfulness of Joseph. He was faithful and he was able to feed everyone in Egypt, and his family as well because his barns were overflowing.

HOW MUCH CAN GOD BLESS YOU? Luke 16:10-11

- God is Watching Us and Testing Us: Proverbs 3:9-10 9 The beauty of the tithe is that it teaches us to trust God. It teaches us that God can do more with the 90% that is blessed than 100% that is not blessed.
- Jesus tells the story of a man who thought everything in the barn was for him. Luke 12:16-19 / 12:20-21 He didn't understand that we are blessed to be a blessing.

This was a guy who had barn blessings with a bag mindset. (Never Enough)
