## The <u>Origin</u> of Man Created by God in <u>His image</u>.

God created us to be in a love relationship with him, in fellowship, and perfect harmony.

- We were created in God's image. Genesis 1:27
  - We are wonderfully made! Psalms 139:14

**Nature** Man has a <u>spiritual</u>, as well as a <u>physical</u> dimension.

- We are Spirit, Soul, and Body. 1 Thessalonians 5:23
- After salvation, our souls begin a transformation process. 2 Corinthians 3:18
- We have a responsibility in this transformation process. Colossians 3:8-17

Next Step – Concerning my transformation process, I will choose to work with Jesus rather than work against Him.

<u>Distinctiveness</u> Man has capacities that go beyond those of any animals and mark him as the pinnacle of God's creation.

Genesis 1:26-28 What makes mankind different from the other animals that we are to have dominion over? • We possess intellect (mind), will, and emotion. Created in the image of God.

• We share some characteristics with other animals, but our characteristics far exceed theirs.

**Destiny** Man will <u>live</u> forever in heaven or hell.

Hebrews 9:27 Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment,

- The Last Judgement. Matthew 25:31-34 / Matthew 25:41 / Matthew 25:46
  - My destiny and your destiny are not determined at The Last Judgement. That is a reading of the verdict and sentencing.
    - Our destiny is determined while we are still here on this earth.

• We are born condemned already. John 3:17-18

 Choosing to receive Jesus as our one and only savior brings us new life, and life eternal. John 3:16-21

Next Step – Today I choose my eternal destiny by receiving Jesus as my savior from sins, and my source of everlasting life.
