The Word of God helps us understand our foe, the evil one. Satan is the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience (Ephesians 2:2), he is the prince or ruler of this world (John12:31), and he is the god of this age who has blinded the minds of unbelievers, lest the gospel of Christ shine on them (2 Corinthians 4:4).
