I Am Not

When Moses really understood that he was standing before the “I AM THAT I AM,” he had to come to the realization that if you are the “I AM THAT I AM,” then I realize that “I (Moses) Am NOT.”

NEXT STEP: This week I will think about the fact that, since God is the I AM, then I Am Not.

The Example of John the Baptist John 1:6-8 / John 1:14-15 / John 1:19-20 / John 1:21-23

We need to get this in our vocabulary. I am not.

We know we are not because we know that He is “I AM” and if God is “I AM”... then “I am not.”

I Am Not! But I know I AM!

The more I get to know I AM. The more I know I am not, but the good news is I know I AM.

Exodus 3:12 / Exodus 3:14 I have come down to rescue them.... I am sending you,
and if anyone questions what you are doing, tell them I AM has sent you!

NEXT STEP: I will do all God is calling me to do in the confidence that I am not, but I know I AM.

Because You Understand I Am Not! But I know I AM!

- **You Walk in I AM’s Purpose and Plan for Your Life** Jeremiah 29:11-13

You are created to do something good that God has planned for you to accomplish. Ephesians 2:10

- **You Will Be Given a New Name in Heaven**

God does loves you and He loves your name, but He has a very special name for you, that you will receive when you get to heaven. Revelation 2:17 Just something a little special between you and Jesus!

- **Your Name is On The Most Important Name List of All Time**

People strive to be “A” listers, to have their names known in important places.

But the most important list of all time is to have your name written in the Lamb’s Book of Life!

Revelation 21:27 / Revelation 20:15 / John 17:3 / John 15:15 / James 4:8

Receive Jesus as your Savior today and declare **I Am Not, but I know I AM.**
